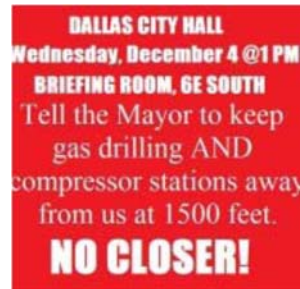


## **The Final Battle Over the Dallas Gas Well Drilling Ordinance is Here!**

This Wednesday and next Wednesday are two public hearings before the City Council on the proposed gas well drilling ordinance. The current voting math is that six council members favor the ordinance as written with its reasonable 1,500 foot setback from residences, while six others would be perfectly happy to allow drilling closer to our neighborhoods. That leaves three uncommitted votes and a need to make sure they support the ordinance. They are Mayor Rawlings, Jennifer Gates and Dwaine Caraway.
